1. University Secretary

The Committee has endorsed the proposed appointment of Dr Tony Strike, Director of Strategy, Planning & Change, to the role of University Secretary, replacing Dr Andrew West, who would leave the University in July 2017.

2. Employability Board

The Committee has approved that Simon Roberts be appointed to the Employability Board with immediate effect until 31 July 2019. Mr Roberts joined Siemens Plc in 2010 and in September 2016 he assumed responsibility for Entry Level Talent Acquisition in the position of Talent Acquisition Manager. In this role he is responsible for overseeing transformation in how Siemens delivers entry level talent recruitment.

3. Human Resources Committee

The Committee has approved that Ms Mandy Coalter, Director of People, United Learning be appointed to the Human Resources Committee with immediate effect until 31 July 2019. Ms Coalter joined United Learning in November 2012 having previously worked in local government, health, the voluntary sector and with schools.
